ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

- WW-P Film Festival entries can be created in any format (film, digital, video, animation, flash, etc.) but must be submitted on commercially playable DVD, DV, or VHS media.
- All films must be in English or subtitled in English. The use of copyrighted elements, e.g. musical recordings, is prohibited.
- Films can be created by individuals or groups but *must* be the work of student filmmakers, <u>not</u> parents or teachers. Production credits should accurately indicate each phase of the production process, e.g. writing, casting, camerawork, editing, mixing, and scoring, was solely the result of student participation.
- Maximum length of submission is 10 minutes.
- Ten seconds of video black needs to precede and follow presentation.
- Films will not be returned. Please include an e-mail address with film to acknowledge receipt of entry.
- There is no cost for each entry; please use official form.
- Submit filmmaker biography or back story of no more than 250 words.

DEADLINE

• Films must be submitted by April 7, 2010. Please submit the films to Mr. Jamie Watson, Station Manager, at High School North.

WHAT IF MY FIILM IS ACCEPTED?

- All films will be shown on West Windsor and Plainsboro Township Cable stations during the hours designated for the West Windsor-Plainsboro Regional School District.
- All films will be reviewed by the station manager for appropriateness for broadcast. All submission rejections resulting from inappropriate content will be final.
- Films will be rated by the viewing public and a panel of judges. The top ten films will be presented from June through August over the cable stations in a "Best of Show" program hosted by the winning student film makers.

Non-compliant submissions will be disqualified.
