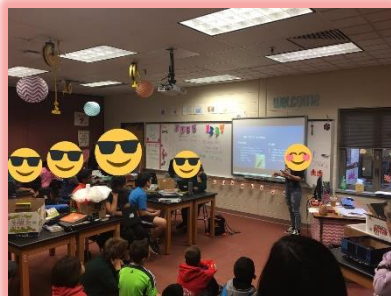
Thank you for supporting the PTSA Scholastic Book Fair which helped raise funds for our Media Center.



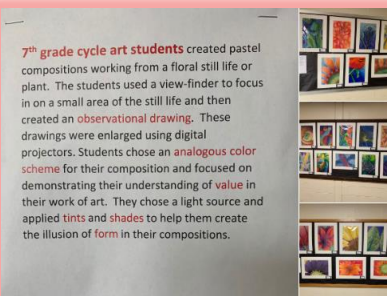
CMS hosted parents for Coffee with the Principal to discuss middle school practices, policies and expectations.

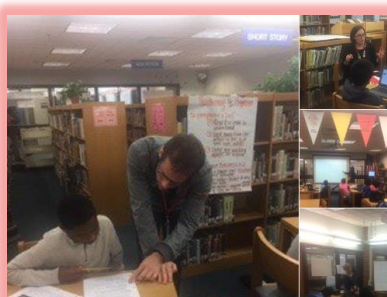
Talented art students in cycle and elective art have their finished pieces displayed throughout CMS.
