## WW-P HIGH SCHOOL COURSE PLANNER

Students enroll in eight courses/subjects per year (35 credits), one of which is a mandatory study hall.

However, Financial Literacy may be taken out of study hall for an additional 2.5 credits once during a four year sequence. Students may also choose to take another core subject course as their "elective" though completion of graduation requirements should be the priority. Please note: Middle School courses do not count towards high school graduation requirements with the exception of Algebra I.
