18 Year Old Attendance Policy

The **Age of Majority Law** considers **eighteen-year-old students** adults in New Jersey. However, the law also gives the school the right to control the conduct of all students whether eighteen or younger.

1. Eighteen-year-old students may sign their own dismissal notes. The student then signs out in the attendance office at the approved time. **Parents will be notified of all requests to leave early.** Doctor visits will only be considered excused upon receipt of medical documentation. **All class absences will be treated as unexcused until verification is provided.**
2. Eighteen-year-old students may sign their own field trip permission slips, exemption forms, and physical forms without prior approval of school authorities.
3. Eighteen-year-old students are subject to all other regulations according to school policy.
4. Eighteen-year-old students MAY NOT sign themselves out sick. They MUST be dismissed by the nurse.
