The Anti-Bullying Bill of Rights Act requires that the week beginning with the first Monday in October (October 7-11) of each year be designated as a "Week of Respect" in New Jersey. School districts are required to observe the week by providing age-appropriate instruction focusing on preventing harassment, intimation or bullying.
