Chamber Club and CJMEA Honors Orchestra Auditions:

All students who play an orchestra instrument are invited to audition for Chamber Club on Wednesday, Feb. 5 or Thursday, Feb. 6 after school. Chamber club is an advanced orchestra group that plays music at the middle and high school level. Students must be able to read notes on all four strings of their instrument, and demonstrate proficiency with the "Low 2" skill. All auditioners must prepare a solo piece (NOT orchestra music) demonstrating these skills, at least at the end of Suzuki book 1 or its equivalent. They will also be asked to sight read a short excerpt at their audition. Current chamber club students do not need to re-audition.

5th grade students who audition but are not accepted to chamber club will be considered for the CJMEA Honors Orchestra. This honors orchestra is a one-day event in April (exact date TBA) where advanced students play grade-level pieces with other advanced students in the central NJ area. Date, time, and location details TBA. *In order to be considered for this honors orchestra, students must audition for chamber club.* Please see above for repertoire requirements.
