Science Fair Tips

A Science Fair project attempts to answer a question. It requires research, organization and the desire to find answers to real-life questions. It does not need to be complicated or complex in nature. The more focused and specific the question the scientist asks, the easier it can be to research and present the findings. Therefore, the first thing a young scientist needs to do is select an appropriate topic and ask an appropriate scientific question. Parents can help guide their child in this process keeping in mind that the goal is to make sure this is a project, and a process that is driven by the child's curiosity and not the parent's desire to have a perfect presentation.
