Remote Learning Reminders:

- Please remember that district devices and email accounts are only for school-related activities.
- If you or your child need assistance, please email CMS@ww-p.org. This email is being monitored during weekdays, from 9 a.m. 1 p.m..
- If your child is ill, please note it in Genesis as usual and there is no need to email your child's individual teachers. Please take care of yourselves and your family.
- Students will be able to complete work on their own schedule and will have real time access to teacher feedback during the "office hours" below.
- Students should follow teachers' instructions on their teachers' Google Classrooms.
- Students will receive feedback via Google Classroom (not on Genesis) from their teachers.
- Students should be sure to hit **"Submit"** when completing assignments via Google Classroom.
- Students should submit questions to teachers during the designated "office hours" period/day/time via Google Classroom or email their teachers directly.
- Teachers will check email, give feedback on assignments, and/or respond to students' comments and questions during designated "office hours" period/day/time.
- Teachers may participate in a Google Hangout with their students and students will have access to Google Hangout from 8:30 a.m.- 1:30 p.m. Monday through Friday.

• During remote learning days, Panthers stay connected to #TeamCommUNITY and WWPRSD communications. Follow teachers and administrators on Twitter for district and personal updates. We want you to stay informed and encouraged!

- Remember to follow the CDC guidelines, maintain social distancing and utilize proper hand-washing. We want all our Panthers to be safe and healthy during this time.
- Organize your day so you have time to complete school assignments and eat a healthy breakfast, snack and lunch while learning remotely.
