School Updates

- Textbook Return: Due to construction at HSS front parking lot and HVAC renovations, students need to return their textbooks, uniforms, library books, musical scripts, and other school equipment except for Chromebooks next week.
 - o 11th grade students on Wednesday, June 10, from 1-4 p.m.
 - o 10th grade students on Thursday, June 11, from 1-4 p.m.
 - 9th grade students on Friday, June 12, from 1-4 p.m.
 - If you have a student in more than one grade at HSS, please drop off textbooks on the day assigned to the oldest child. This applies for students in grades 9-11 only. Seniors will have their own process. For more information click here.
- **Disney Refunds:** This week you will receive your Disney refund in the mail. We were able to recover approximately 90 percent of the cost when you add in the flight voucher. Again pending legislation, the voucher could become cash. Please know we have balanced the amount of the checks in relation to the voucher. One flight received 20 dollars more for their voucher, so they will receive 20 dollars less in their mailed check.
- Senior Photographs and Senior Boxes: On June 15 and June 16 (rain date on June 18), students in the Class of 2020 will be able to choose a time to come to HSS to have their picture taken by a professional photographer on a stage wearing their cap and gown. They will also have the opportunity to have a professional photographer take a picture of them in front of the sign on the corner of Penn Lyle and Clarksville Rd.
 - You will need to select a time and arrive at the hour or half-hour previous to your chosen time. HSS staff will provide directions for parking and moving from one location to the next. We ask that parents stay on the assigned sidewalk where they will be able to take pictures

- of their graduate. We need to remember to keep appropriate social distancing at all times.
- Between the two locations, students can pick up their Senior box which will contain the Graduation programs, yearbook if they ordered it, scholarship and/ or department awards they earned and some other surprises.
- Important: The senior box has their name on the sides and lid along with the numbers corresponding to their Chromebook. On Friday, June 19, students or parents can bring the senior box back to school filled with the graduates' textbooks, Chromebook, charger, library books, musical scripts, and any other school-issued supplies/equipment that needs to be returned. In exchange for the senior box, we will issue the student's diploma.
