- Disney Refunds: Disney refunds should be arriving in the mail. We were able to recover approximately 90 percent of the cost when you add in the flight voucher. Again pending legislation, the voucher could become cash. Please know we have balanced the amount of the checks in relation to the voucher. One flight received 20 dollars more for their voucher, so they will receive 20 dollars less in their mailed check.
- Yearbook Update: Yearbooks will not arrive until Tuesday afternoon.
 - Seniors who purchased a yearbook will receive it with their diploma
 Friday, June 19, when they return their textbooks, Chromebooks, and other school property.
 - Underclassmen, we will share a schedule to pick up yearbooks early next week.
- Important Senior Reminder: The senior box has your name on the sides and lid, along with the numbers corresponding to your Chromebook. On Friday, June 19, students or parents should bring the senior box back to school filled with the graduate's textbooks, Chromebook, charger, library books, musical scripts, and any other school-issued supplies/equipment that

needs to be returned. In exchange for the senior box, we will issue the student's diploma.

- Students who need to pick-up belongings that were left in school should have completed the form that was sent out this week via email. Students who responded will be provided with a time next week to enter through the new gym. They will be escorted by security and the students must wear a mask. Hall locker items will be in marked bags on the gym floor (by locker number) as well as other clothing items that were left in the school.
