We enter this school year in unusual and unprecedented circumstances; however, the district's faculty and administration have worked tirelessly to make the transition as seamless as possible.

We want to begin by thanking you for the enthusiastic reception of the programs launched by the PTSA last year and the tremendous support offered by the community for the fundraisers that enabled those programs. Last year:

- We launched a Coffee with the Counselors series for member Parents as well as invited guest speakers to speak at our general meetings.
- We awarded \$2,100 in mini-grants to HSS faculty and staff for special programs and sponsored breakfast on the first PD day and dinner on BTSN.
- For our student members, we held the SAT fair, conducted a free practice SAT/ACT test, and gave out 3,500 in PTSA student awards. In addition, through the craft fair, we sponsored \$2,750 in school scholarships and gave out \$2,100 to school clubs by employing them to help out at the fair.

This year, we are working hard to continue to provide value to our community AND to keep the community connected so that our children can continue to thrive.

- Our counselors will continue to have coffee meet-ups over zoom calls
- We are working on lining up exciting speakers.
- We are also working on a new initiative to build an alumni database that student members can access and use to connect with alums.

• We will do our utmost to ensure a safe Post Prom for the graduating class of 2021, as well as to continue to provide student awards.
