Community Education

- **Integrated Preschool:** Integrated Preschool <u>waitlist</u> registration to begin Monday, April 19, at 9 a.m. This program is available to a limited number of students for the 2021-22 school year. The waitlist is not a guarantee for a seat in next year's classroom. We are currently working on the schedule and determining a safe number of students for each classroom.
