SCHOOL

As we see a spike in the number of COVID-19 cases in our area and around the globe, we know that there are heightened levels of anxiety in ourselves and in our families. We want our families to know some of the ways in which we help support the social-emotional needs of our Dutch Neck Dexter Dragons, in addition to their academic needs.

Our school is modeled using the principles of *Responsive Classroom*. Responsive Classroom is a student-centered, social and emotional learning approach to teaching. It is an approach that focuses on engaging academics, and a positive school community. Click <u>HERE</u> to learn more about Responsive Classroom practices. Your child also participates in *morning meetings* to grow and strengthen their social connections with peers. In addition, our students participate in *mindfulness activities* with their classroom teachers, and *lessons* about stress, worry, expressing feeling and coping skills with our school counselor, Mrs. Nancy Dunne.
