- **Back-to-School Nights:** It was a pleasure to welcome you to our Back to School Nights! We hope you enjoyed meeting your child's teachers and getting an overview of the curriculum and your child's day. We know it's been a few years since we hosted an in-person Back to School Night, so it was especially nice to see and meet so many of you. In case you missed the opening video or you were unable to attend, we have linked it here. Also, if you didn't get an opportunity to meet each of your child's special area teachers, you can watch a short video of each teacher introducing themselves and their programs here.
- **Label ALL Personal Belongs:** Please be sure to label ALL of your child(ren)'s personal belongings. This will help ensure that personal belongings left behind in the classroom, on the buses or in the cafeteria will be returned to the owner. Please include name, grade, and teacher.
- **Safety:** Dutch Neck Elementary School would like to remind parents/caretakers of the following information in a continued effort to make sure our students are safe during arrival and dismissal times:
 - Morning Parent Drop Off:
 - 8:40-8:55 a.m. is drop off for kindergarten-3rd grade students.
 - Drop off is a single lane system. For everyone's safety, no one is permitted to pass cars at any time during drop off. The system in place moves quickly and efficiently so we ask for your patience as students exit cars and come into the building. Students can only be dropped off at this designated area. No students should be dropped off where school buses are entering or exiting.
 - Crossing the street: Please make sure that you and your child ONLY cross the street at the designated crossing area. A crossing guard is posted there during arrival and dismissal times.
 - Parent Pick Up

- Please always make sure to send a note in with your child if you are picking them up at the end of the day. The note should have the date, your child's name, the intent that they will be going to parent pick-up and what adult will be picking them up.
- Buses Only Parking Lot: Between the hours of 8:30-9 a.m. and 3-3:30 p.m. the left lot (by the gym and cafeteria) is closed with the exception of school buses. There are signs up as reminders that no cars should be entering or parking during those times.
- There is extra parking available on the street and across the street in the Windsor Chapel parking lot.
- Thank you again for your patience and caution when in the Dutch Neck area in an effort to provide a safe space for our young children.

Technology

- District issued Chromebooks for students in grades kindergarten through grade 3 are kept in the classroom.
- District issued Chromebooks for students in grades 4-12 are for students to use both in school and to take home.
 - Students should bring their fully charged Chromebooks to school with them each day.
 - Charging cords should remain at home.
 - Middle school families: The Chromebook cover from last year's device should be used on this year's device. If you do not have a cover from last year, please follow the process at your school to submit tech ticket so that we can provide a cover.
- District Chromebooks need to be brought to school and logged in to by each student prior to State testing.
 - Students should bring the device to school, log in to the District device with their District email and test that their device is in good working order.
 If any issues are discovered, please follow the process at your school to submit a tech ticket for support.
