- **Parent Gradebook Grade Alerts via Genesis**: Effective Tuesday, Nov. 15, 2022, parents/guardians who have registered to receive Gradebook alerts via Genesis will receive one daily email notification that will summarize all updates made to your student's gradebook by their teachers since the previous daily summary was sent. This will eliminate the multiple emails sent to families on a daily basis from Genesis for each class/grade entered.
 - If parents/guardians wish to subscribe to receive this summary email, they may do so via <u>Genesis</u> in the "Message Center" under the "Message Alert Setup" tab.
- **Referendum/Capital Project Tours:** On Saturday, Dec. 3, 2022, from 9 a.m. -12 p.m. WW-P will be holding capital project and referendum building tours for parents/guardians and community members to come into Maurice Hawk, Town Center, CMS, GMS, and HSS to experience the new and redone spaces that have been created and redesigned for our students and staff.

- Early Dismissal Requests for Students: Parents/guardians notifying school attendance office/school secretary of a student early dismissal can be done via TeleSafe, a note in the "Daily Attendance" tab in Genesis Parent Portal or by emailing/sending a note to your school's attendance secretary.
