Reminders

- **Grade 11 NJGPA Testing:** March 14-17, 2023, WW-P grade 11 students will take the NJGPA assessment. High School North and High School South ONLY will run a revised schedule and two morning bus runs on those dates. Juniors will come in at their usual time. Students in grades 9, 10, and 12 will be picked up on the second bus run, two hours and 15 minutes after the normal pickup time. All high school students will follow a shortened period schedule following testing each day March 14-17.
- **Kindergarten registration for the 2023-2024 school year** is now open. Parents/guardians must complete the online application and make a phone appointment for registration. For more information and to begin the process, please click <u>here</u>.
- **Title 1 Information**: Title 1 is a federal program under the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) as reauthorized by the No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (NCLB). The following WW-P schools receive Title 1 funding: Maurice Hawk Elementary School, Town Center Elementary School, Millstone River School, Village School, Wicoff Elementary School and High School South. - **Parent Gradebook Grade Alerts via Genesis**: Effective Tuesday, Nov. 15, 2022, parents/guardians who have registered to receive Gradebook alerts via Genesis will receive one daily email notification that will summarize all updates made to your student's gradebook by their teachers since the previous daily summary was sent. This will eliminate the multiple emails sent to families on a daily basis from Genesis for each class/grade entered.
 - If parents/guardians wish to subscribe to receive this summary email, they may do so via <u>Genesis</u> in the "Message Center" under the "Message Alert Setup" tab.
- Early Dismissal Requests for Students: Parents/guardians notifying school attendance office/school secretary of a student early dismissal can be done via TeleSafe, a note in the "Daily Attendance" tab in Genesis Parent Portal or by emailing/sending a note to your school's attendance secretary.

- **Contact Information:** Is your contact information up-to-date in Genesis? If your email or phone numbers have changed, please make sure to update your information in Genesis.
 - Interested in receiving SMS text notifications from the District?: If you would like to opt-in to receive SMS text messages from the District, please text "Yes" to "67587" from a cellphone that is listed in your contact information in Genesis.
