Meet the Counselors Sessions What are these sessions?



Genesis Student Information System



Maintaining correct and up-to-date information in the student information system, <u>Genesis</u>, is critical. Please be certain that all contact information in your student's account is correct. <u>Current telephone numbers and email addresses</u> are necessary to receive information or for contact during an emergency. Whenever possible, please supply multiple points of contact and add <u>emergency contacts</u>.



Parent/Teacher Conferences



Conferences are scheduled on the district calendar from October 10th through October 13th. Teachers arrange these schedules through <u>Genesis</u>, the student information system. It is advisable to become familiar with Genesis if you have not already done so. Teachers will communicate the process for scheduling closer to those dates. Early dismissal occurs on these dates and students will be dismissed at 1:00 pm.



Cell Phones and Social Media



We recognize that some families have made the decision to provide their child with a cell phone. Please be advised that cell phone use is not permitted during the school day. Cell phones must remain in backpacks and turned off. Smart watches shall not be used for communication during the school day. Students calling home should only do so under the supervision of an adult. Any ill student must see the school nurse.





Social media sites such as, Facebook, Instagram, TikTok and others have their appropriate uses. We share a strong caution that students in grade 3-5 are not of the appropriate age to have a personal social media account. These services require everyone to be 13 years of age and older. Though some feel it is permissible with monitoring, the content on these sites is often not appropriate for children. Additionally, discussions on such sites often lead to negative social interactions that impact school and can equate to bullying.

Students will have access to electronic devices through school and Google accounts. Please be advised that these accounts are monitored and we are notified of any inappropriate use of language or search content. Students must follow our Acceptable Use Policy. We ask your cooperation in providing safe guidelines for use during unstructured times and monitoring.

Age appropriateness, brain development and safety are critical in relation to access to devices and sites that expose children to many topics. At any time, please feel free to reach out to our counselors or principal team for guidance on these topics.
