Community Education

- **Mini Explorers** is a Community Education program for four-year-olds. This program is open to students who reside in West Windsor and Plainsboro who turn four on or before Oct. 1 of this school year. Children must be fully potty trained to be eligible for this program.
 - The program will follow the West Windsor Plainsboro Regional School District school year calendar and will be held at Wicoff Elementary School from 9 a.m. - 3 p.m. Parents/guardians must provide their own transportation.
 - Students will follow a daily schedule designed and taught by WW-P Community Education staff members.
 - For the 2023-2024 school year, the monthly cost for this program is \$1,020.

Technology
