• Referendum Updates

Dr. Russo, Assistant Superintendent for Finance, discussed potential options for District solar power via the Energy Savings Improvement Program (ESIP). Ceiling work including make-up air units and hood fire suppression have been installed in the High School North culinary arts room while finishing work in the media center including circulation desk and stacks installation continues. Phase II construction at the Wicoff School, including renovation to the media center, main office, nurses suite, and front entrance is underway. Framing, plumbing, and electrical work continues. Punch list items remain in the Millstone River and Dutch Neck School Media Centers with move in underway.

• School Start Time Committee Updates

The Committee reviewed the work of the School Start Time Exploration Committee thus far including current and applicable research and the potential impacts on grade levels, family schedules, and childcare. Also discussed was the upcoming meeting that will focus on transportation and the possible effects of alternative school start times.

• Little Library Project

The committee reviewed a proposal from WWP High School North students to create a "Little Library" outside District elementary schools that would provide free year round access to appropriate grade level texts to support literacy within the community.

Nursing Services Plan

The committee reviewed the District Nursing Services plan for the 2023-2024 school year that supports student health care needs, emergency management, and other health related services.

QSAC Scores

The Committee discussed scores from the 2023 New Jersey Quality Single Accountability Continuum (NJQSAC) review. WWP has been designated as a "high performing" school district and certified by the State Board of Education as providing a thorough and efficient system of education thereby being placed on a continuum in the five NJQSAC areas including Instruction and Program, Fiscal Management, Governance, Operations and Personnel.

• Athletics Updates

The high school fall sports season is underway with nearly a thousand students participating. United football kicked off the season on August 25th with soccer, tennis, volleyball, and field hockey competition beginning the week of September 3rd. The committee discussed ongoing conversations with local schools regarding the possibility of starting a Cricket program.

• Referendum Updates

Punch list items are underway in the High School North culinary arts room and media center. Phase II construction at the Wicoff School continues in the media center, main office, nurse's suite, and front entrance. A new driveway has been poured off Plainsboro Road. Punch list items continue in the Millstone River and Dutch Neck School Media Centers. Construction of a sensory playground at Town Center has begun.

• School Start Time Committee Updates
