Recommendations

Instruction

Curriculum

- align curriculum with CCSS
- provide further vertical and horizontal curriculum articulation

Assessment

- examine how we assess student progress and how we use that data to inform practice
- continue to look for ways to support achievement of all students
- Materials Resources including Technology
 - ensure reliable and equitable access to technology to support instruction
 - update classroom libraries, print and digital, to engage a new generation of readers

Leadership and Professional Development

- continue ongoing professional development across curriculum, including literacy in the content areas
- assess level of support for coaching and supervision of teachers
- Communication and Grading
 - examine how we assess student progress



- consider using portfolios to document student growth to foster successful transitions
- revise report cards to reflect changes made in the curriculum
