

## **Guidelines for Middle School Math Placement**

### **Grade 8 placement for students currently in Math 7 Honors**

Students with a three marking period average of 70% or higher are scheduled to continue in the Honors program.

Students with a three marking period average lower than a 70% are eligible for Algebra 1.

Parents may appeal a student's placement. The principal and supervisor would look at the student's final exam, fourth marking period grade and PARCC scores.

### **Grade 8 placement for students currently in Math 7**

Students with a three marking period average greater than or equal to 80% are eligible for Algebra 1 Honors.

Students with a three marking period average of 70% are eligible for Algebra 1.

Parents may appeal a student's placement. The principal and supervisor would look at the student's final exam, fourth marking period grade and PARCC scores.

Students with a three marking period average of less than 70% are eligible for Math 8.

Parents may appeal a student's placement. The principal and supervisor would look at the student's final exam, fourth marking period grade and PARCC scores.

### **Grade 7 placement for current sixth grade**

Students with a final average greater than or equal to 80% would be eligible for Math 7 Honors.

Parents may appeal a student's placement. The principal and supervisor would look at the student's final exam and PARCC scores.

### **H&A Mathematics**

Students in the A&E program need to obtain a final average greater than or equal to 70% in order to be eligible to continue in the program.
