## Summary AP Results 2018

- $75 \%$ of $11^{\text {th }}$ and $12^{\text {th }}$ grade students took at least one AP course in the 2017-2018 school year.
- $94.5 \%$ of $11^{\text {th }}$ and $12^{\text {th }}$ grade students enrolled in an AP course scored a 3 or above on at least one AP test in the 2017-2018 school year.
